The Scholarship pays for all course enrollment fees and up to \$500 for required textbook fees per semester.

The Eastern Sierra Foundation, formed to promote higher education in the Eastern Sierra, has created the Eastern Sierra Foundation Scholarship. The scholarship is available to any California resident (at least one year residency required) who resides in Inyo County. Applicants must attend Cerro Coso Community College, on the Bishop Campus, as a full-time student (12 units or more).

All applicants also need to complete the EOPS and FAFSA applications.
